- How do I talk to the teacher if I do not speak English?

Housing

- Why do I have an apartment? Why can't I have a house?
- It's expensive in the United States. Who will pay for my housing?

Health

- How will I pay for my medical expenses?
- Who will help me get my prescriptions?
- What happens if my children are sick? What do I do?
